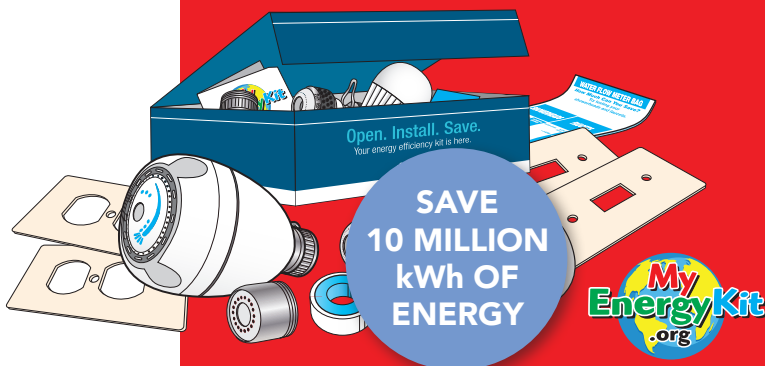




THE SHOW
