HOW? Bake homemade chocolate chip cookies & earn 1 service hour per 1 dozen cookies donated

WHY? To perform Corporal Works of Mercy for the imprisoned at the Warren Correctional Institution

WHERE? Bake cookies at home, freeze them, package as instructed below and deliver them to STM Dinning Hall

WHEN? ½ Hour before & after all 4 Masses on the weekend of October 28 & 29 & Monday Oct 30 before 3PM.

Kairos cookies should be prayed over while being made! This is an important part of what makes them special! Please make chocolate chip cookies with no nuts, raisins or powdered sugar or anything else added. A chocolate chip cookie recipe is included below. Cookies should be about 2"-3" in diameter and well cooled. Stack one dozen in each gallon Ziploc bag (important: bags should not have a separate plastic tab which slides to close them...they should be Ziploc or the generic equivalent). Cookies should be sturdy as they will be handled a lot, especially by the corrections officers as they are taken into the prison.

CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIE RECIPE

2 1/4 cups of all-purpose flour-----1 teaspoon of baking soda

1 teaspoon of salt-----2 large eggs

3/4 cup of granulated sugar------3/4 cup of packed brown sugar

1 cup (2 sticks) of butter, softened-----1 teaspoon of vanilla extract

2 cups (12-oz. pkg) chocolate chip morsels

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Mix flour, baking soda and salt in a small bowl. Beat butter, granulated sugar, brown sugar and vanilla extract in large mixer bowl until creamy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Gradually beat in flour mixture. Stir in morsels. Drop by rounded tablespoon onto ungreased baking sheets. BAKE for 9 to 11 minutes or until golden brown. Cool on baking sheets for 2 minutes; remove to wire racks to cool completely.
