The Grassy Run Historical Arts Committee is pleased to invite you and your students to the Twenty Seventh Annual Grassy Run Heritage Rendezvous to be held at the Williamsburg Community Park, located at 150 E. Main St. in Williamsburg. Our school day program will be on Friday, April 28 from 9 AM to 3 PM with public days on April 28 & 29, 2018.

This is a pre-1840 event so the demonstrations and displays pertain to the time when settlers were first making their way into the "Ohio country" to make new homes for themselves and their families. Please remind your students that the weapons and tools on display are real and in some cases very sharp. Please do not touch anything without being invited to. Also, the tents are our homes for the weekend and should be treated with the same respect as anyone else's home.

Some of the activities planned, many of which are hands-on, are storytelling, first person interpreters, blacksmithing, woodworking, rope making, tin punch, weaving and spinning, writing with a quill pen and many others.

The cost is \$2.00 per student. It is recommended that chaperones be provided for making groups of 6 to 8 students.
