- -Choir leads the music at every school Mass during the school year

Can Children Participate in More?

- -Yes! In addition to the children's choir, all children grade 6-8 are welcome to participate in the Teen-Adult Choir that sings at the 10 AM Mass on Sundays.
- -All members of the children's choir (all ages) are also welcome to sing with our parish guitar group at the 4 PM Saturday Mass.
- -Children in grades 6-8 have the option to lead as cantor at the school Masses.
- -Children in grades 6-8 in the Teen-Adult Choir have the opportunity to be selected as Cantors for the 10 AM Mass

What is a Cantor?

The Cantor is in charge of leading the responsorial psalm at the school Mass, and the psalm and gospel acclamation at the 10 AM Mass. These are songs where the verses are done by one individual, rather than the entire choir. The Cantor leads these verses solo with the director.
